## <u>Safety & Etiquette Reminders – Dogwood Pickleball</u>

Dear Players,

With so many **new members** joining our Dogwood Pickleball community, now is the perfect time to refresh everyone, both new and seasoned players—on some **important safety and etiquette reminders** that help keep our games safe, fair, and enjoyable for all.

## Key Safety Reminders

- No running when entering or leaving the courts walk carefully to avoid collisions.
- **Loose balls** never toss them blindly. Please return directly to a player or roll along the ground.
- Ball on court if a ball enters your court, call out "Ball On!" loudly, stop play, and replay the rally.
- Be court aware stay clear of active courts when walking to or from your court.
- **Footwear** wear proper, dry court shoes. The Forum floor can be slippery.
- After finishing a game please walk directly to the back wall, then over to the paddle buckets. This helps avoid crossing active play.

## Play Etiquette Reminders

- Introduce yourself to new partners and opponents.
- Stronger players: keep the game fun and balanced, share play, and use slams wisely.
- Rotate fairly using the Forum Bucket Play process.
- Game format we play straight to 11 points, no 2-point difference required.
- **Court rotation** new players always enter on the end courts; players on end courts move inward.
- Exit the court promptly once your match is finished.

## Forum Processes & Respectful Play

- Registration to support as many members as possible, please register for only one session per day. If there are open spots on the day of play, you may register for a second session. For extra play time, take advantage of the City Forum Drop-In sessions.
- Withdrawing if you cannot attend your session, please withdraw the night before if possible—or at minimum, 60 minutes prior. This allows another player the chance to join.
- Net takedown when rolling up the nets, do not remove the end poles.
  Please leave them in place.
- **Leaving early** if you need to leave before the session ends, sign out on the attendance sheet.
- Questions or concerns speak directly with your Pickleball Activity Lead.

Thank you for helping us maintain a **safe, friendly, and welcoming environment** for everyone. Whether you are just starting out or have years of experience, these reminders ensure we all enjoy the game to the fullest.
