DWSS ROUND ROBIN PICKLEBALL TOURNAMENT

Participant Procedures & Tournament Rules

TOURNAMENT SETUP

- A. Once the tournament invitation has been distributed, registration will be capped at 24 players, with 2 designated spares.
- B. Player names (24) will be randomly drawn from a hat:
 - The first name drawn will be assigned Player #1, continuing in order up to Player #24.
- C. All player numbers and names will be recorded on the large tournament play board and score sheet.
- D. The large play board is to be preserved—do not write directly on it.
- E. The two spares will:
 - Organize and maintain the playboard and score sheet.
 - Fill in as a player if someone is unavailable.

TOURNAMENT RULES & PROCEDURES

- 1. There will be 6 courts, clearly labeled as Court #1 to Court #6.
- 2. Each player will have an assigned player number (1–24).
 - Please remember your number.
 - If forgotten, it can be found on the play board.
- 3. The large play board will display:
 - Courts #1 to #6
 - Games #1 to #8
 - Each court/game combination will show 4 player numbers.
- 4. Court Sides & Service:
 - The top two numbers listed per court are assigned the north side and are the starting servers.
- 5. Game Format:
 - Games are played to 11 points.
 - No need to win by 2 points.
- 6. After each game:
 - Each player must record their individual score beside their name, in the box corresponding to the game number.
- 7. Pacing the Event:
 - All games in a round (Game #1 to Game #8) must be fully completed before proceeding to the next round.
 - A whistle will signal the start of each new game.

- 8. After the final round:
 - All player scores will be totaled and recorded on the score sheet.
- 9. Tournament Management:
 - The two spares will:
 - Oversee the event setup and logistics.
 - Step in as substitute players if needed.

REMINDERS TO ALL PARTICIPANTS

- Respect the schedule and listen for whistle signals.
- Check the board for your player number and court assignments.
- Record your score immediately after each game.
- Have fun and enjoy the spirit of friendly competition!
