



How Do I Join the Dogwood Seniors 50+ Pickleball Activity Group – FAQ

1. How do I start participating?

You must hold a valid 2026 Dogwood Seniors Society membership (available starting November 1, 2025). Memberships and renewals are completed in person at the Dogwood Pavilion Ambassador Desk — online registration is not available. Cost: \$10 per year (cash, cheque, credit, or debit). Hours: Monday–Friday, 9:00 AM–3:00 PM (call ahead to confirm availability). Bring your membership card for a 2026 sticker or request a replacement if lost. 2025 memberships expire December 31, 2025.

2. What else do I need to play?

You must have a City of Coquitlam recreation account. This account is used to register, reserve, and pay for all Dogwood Pickleball sessions. For assistance, contact Coquitlam Registration at 604-927-4386.

3. Can I observe before registering?

Yes. You're encouraged to observe your preferred session before joining to ensure it matches your level of play. Sessions are pre-registered drop-ins — no formal instruction is provided. Participants should understand the rules, scoring, safety practices, and etiquette.

4. What if I can't attend a registered session?

If you cannot attend, log in to your Coquitlam City account and withdraw as soon as possible, ideally the evening before. This opens a spot for another player. Register for only one session per day and bring your Dogwood membership card to show the Pickleball Leads at check-in.

5. How and when do I register?

Log in to your City of Coquitlam account and search for Dogwood Seniors Society (members only) Pickleball sessions. Registration opens 48 hours in advance. Some sessions fill quickly due to popularity.

6. Are there other Pickleball options?

Yes. You may also register for Forum City Pickleball sessions listed under Adult (Pre-registration recommended).
